

ring in the Peruvian jungle. The posting features a smiling woman (whom we presume to be Rodriguez herself) cradling a doomed rooster in the coliseum she and her husband built behind their home. In three days, she had her loan. Complaining e-mails plunked into Kiva's customer service inbox, and an anonymous posting on www.indybay.org denounced the nonprofit's lack of an animal rights policy.

Kiva says Rodriguez' submission was red-flagged by one of the volunteers who look over the postings, but they let it go through after its Peruvian lending partner assured them it was kosher there. Animal-rights lawyers say that while "aiding and abetting" cockfighting is a misdemeanor in California punishable by up to a year in prison and a \$5,000 fine, and federal law prohibits shipping animals across state or country borders for fighting, it's
